Jeff: This email will detail why I am requesting to speak to the Board at the meeting this week.

1. Lack of a mail drop for afterhours delivery in the hospital lobby and why, as of this morning, the Board Members don't have my January 31 response (which Mr. Ferguson specifically requested).

On January 31 I dropped off hand-addressed business size letter envelopes to the members of the board in a brown wooden box outside the HR office. I looked around the lobby of the hospital and did not see a mail drop and did not want to leave the envelopes on the (unsecured) desk of the information booth and there was no label on the brown box. Several weeks later I had not heard back from any members of the Board (or you) so I had my landlady check with the information booth at the hospital the next time she was at the hospital (Feb 13 or so). She said she checked with the person at the information booth who told her they had been delivered. Several days later I got a voice message from Ashley Lidlow (sp?) who said it was February 17 and she was leaving on vacation and what
