Dear Mr. Winegardner,

This letter is sent to clarify your current status at Moore County Hospital District. The recent Criminal Trespass Warning was issued due to your increasingly harassing and intimidating behavior with our employees. MCHD has a right to protect our employees from such behaviors and we are exercising this right.

In regards to your status in the Indigent Care Plan, you may continue to participate in the program, subject to all policies, and provided that you qualify. Due to the Criminal Trespass Warrant, you will need to process all paperwork with our eligibility staff via the US Postal Service, phone, fax, or e-mail.

If you believe you have a medical emergency, then you may utilize MCHD's Emergency Department where you will be seen and treated according to the doctor's assessment of your condition. However, any threatening or disruptive behavior will result in the Dumas Police Department being called.

Finally, finding and maintaining a relationship with a physician is your responsibility, not the responsibility of the Indigent Care Program. The ICP has made efforts to assist you with this need in both Amarillo and Dumas. Unfortunately, your conduct, at least in the Dumas office, resulted in your expulsion from that provider's practice.

I trust that this letter adequately addresses your situation.
