

Dear People:

For the past several months I have been receiving diabetic prescriptions from the above program, however, with the arrival of a new unreasonable Indigent Care manager my application for monthly services has not been processed. When I protested this to the hospital's CEO (in an email), he had the local police department issue a "Police Officer's Trespass Warning" which states I am "forbidden to return to...all Moore County Hospital properties and should he return he will be arrested and charged with TRESPASSING." However, he made no previous complaints to me or to the local police department. The POTW form is attached for your review, as well as the e-mail which I sent which apparently precipitated his action, so you can verify there is no justification for his action.

This is a problem because I have an urgent need for medical services: I am experiencing excruciating pain in my right foot (diabetic neuropathy??) and also need to have my diabetes, hypertension and cholesterol medication refilled. I requested the CEO reimburse me for the gasoline required to obtain medical services in the nearest town, Amarillo, and he has ignored this request.

Can you help me with this problem? If you are not the appropriate agency to contact, would you forward this letter to them? I am sending a copy of this letter to the CEO so he is aware of my complaint with you and can defend his actions. Thank you in advance for your assistance.

On April 18, 2012 I was watering my flowers when a local police officer came up to me and asked me to sign that I had received a notice (attached as #1). I did and asked him what it was about. He said "I do not know and I do not want to know."

This occurred about 3 hours after I sent the following email (attached as #2).

In response I wrote a letter (attached as #3) to 2 Amarillo attorneys, Hermann & Weaver and Vaavia Edwards. I did not hear back from either.

In the next 2 days, I wrote 2 letters (attached as #4) to the Dumas Police Department, telling them why I felt the warnings were unconstitutional but I HAVE NEVER received a direct response.

On April 20, 2012 I received an UNDATED letter from the CEO of the local hospital rationalizing his filing the police report attached as #5. However, there had been no previous warnings, verbal or written, no calling the police, NO NOTHING. I wrote a response to the CEO, attached as #6. In addition, my landlady has been present at all of the interactions with the hospital staff. The last paragraph of the letter contained a blatant lie regarding a local physician. I sent the attached letter #7 to that physician.

On 5/01/2012, not having read the Warning correctly, I went to the Moore County Hospital District's Financial Services Office and several minutes later the police arrived. My request for records and the Incident Report is attached as #8.

Several days later I received a response from the City of Dumas Police Department incorrectly dated 5/02/2012 (I did not receive a phone call telling me the records were ready until the middle of May). That letter is attached as #9.

When I saw that a request had been made to the Texas Attorney General's office (presumably May 2, on April 17, 2012 and April 18, 2012 I wrote my own letters to them, attached as #10). As of this morning (May 22), not having received a response, I called the Texas Attorney General's office. They were terrible. They told me they do not accept faxes, have not since last November, do not even have a fax number for their office and do not have any record of my letters on their computer.

A couple of days ago I sent an email of complaint to the Texas Department of State Health Services, attached as #11. It describes how my April application for health services was denied on the basis of forged documents. Attachment 12 shows the altered documents. Notice how on May 1 my application was denied and 2 days later, after sending my appeal, I was instantly granted coverage.

I have not done anything to deserve this. In January I wrote the hospital CEO and told him a local pharmacy was gouging the hospital district and was told that "MCHD is looking into the medication pricing issue at The Pillbox" (see attached documents #13).

My personal liberty has been infringed by the illegal "Police Officer's Trespass Warning" - My picture is posted in the Physical Therapy Department in the room adjacent to the Financial Services Office with a caption stating "If you see this man in the hospital call 911" I have not been able to accompany my landlady as moral support to the hospital lab to get her blood drawn, have not been able to attend diabetic support group meetings (#14) and have to carry papers (Jeff Turner's undated letter) with me to the emergency room, unlike other people.

I would like to sue the hospital district and the CEO for libel, intentional infliction of emotional distress, filing a false police report, punitive damages and denial of my civil rights.
